Your Facility Response Plan for Universal Environmental Solutions, submitted in accordance with Title 33 Code of Federal Regulations Part 154.1017, is approved for a five-year period that begins on the date of this letter.

I commend your efforts in developing a response plan that reflects your company's operating procedures and organizational structure. Your plan is a vital working document and implementation of the plan will help ensure effective oil spill response and mitigation. Please be sure all parties with responsibilities under the plan are familiar with the plan's procedures and requirements.

Universal Environmental Solutions is prohibited from handling, storing, transporting, transferring, or lightering oil unless it is operating in full compliance with this plan. Compliance includes ensuring that oil spill response resources are in place or are available through contract or other approved means. A copy of the plan should be maintained at the marine-transportation-related portion of your facility; it is recommended that this copy be placed with the facility's operations manual.

The Facility Response Plan must be reviewed annually and resubmitted to the Coast Guard for re-approval at the end of this five year period; the annual review requirements are described in 33 CFR 154.1065. A copy of this letter shall be kept with the plan. If you have any further questions concerning this matter, please contact the Facilities Compliance Branch at (813) 228-2191.
